Garlic Hassleback Potatoes with Herbed Sour Cream

- 16 ounces red new potatoes
- 3 to 5 garlic cloves, thinly sliced
- 4 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Using a wooden spoon as a cradle, place each potato in the spoon and make several parallel slits into each potato top making sure not to slice completely through. Place 3 garlic slices between slits at the crown of each potato. Toss in a medium bowl with butter and olive oil. Place on a baking sheet and sprinkle generously with salt and pepper. Bake until tops are crispy and potatoes are cooked through, about 1 hour. Transfer to a platter and top with Herbed Sour Cream

Herbed Sour Cream:

- 1/2 cup sour cream
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 tablespoon finely chopped fresh parsley leaves
- Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

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Vendor Suite Access



 - The heaviest turkey ever raised was 86 pounds, about the size of a large dog.
